**Datblygiad fflatiau – Safle Hen Westy Marine, Ffordd y Gogledd**

Nodwyd fod y Dirprwy Glerc wedi derbyn ymateb gan Swyddog Gorfodaeth Cynllunio Cyngor Gwynedd ynglŷn â'r mater ar y 29ain o Hydref:

“Yn dilyn ymchwiliad i'r mater, gadarnhaf fod 3 caniatâd ar wahân ar gyfer datblygu 15 o fflatiau ar y safle uchod sef C04A/0569/14/LL, C05A/0058/14/LL a C07A/0863/14/LL. Ymddengys bod yr hen westy wedi cael ei ddymchwel cyn mis

Mai 2009 ac yn ôl cofnodion y Cyngor cychwynwyd gwaith ar y safle yn 2008. Felly o'r wybodaeth hon, mae'n amlwg bod gwaith wedi cychwyn o fewn cyfnodau amser y tri chaniatâd cynllunio.

Yn dilyn trafodaethau pellach gyda'r Asiant, cadarnhawyd mai caniatâd cynllunio C07A /0863/14/LL yw'r caniatâd sydd yn cael ei weithredu gan y datblygwr ar hyn o bryd felly nid oes unrhyw dor rheolaeth cynllunio o ran datblygu'r fflatiau ar y safle.

Gobeithio bod yr uchod yn ymateb i'ch ymholiad.”

Derbyniodd yr aelodau yr ymateb a bu i'r Clerc ddweud y bydd yn gwneud ymholiadau pellach o ran yr iaith Gymraeg, tai fforddiadwy a'r Cynllun Datblygu Unedol.

### **Development of Flats - Former Marine Hotel Site, North Road**

It was noted that the Deputy Clerk had received a response from Gwynedd Council's Planning Enforcement Officer regarding the matter on the 29th October:

“Following an investigation into the matter, I confirm that there are 3 separate consents for the development of 15 flats on the above site, namely C04A/0569/14/LL, C05A/ 0058/14/LL and C07A/0863/14/LL. The former hotel appears to have been demolished before May 2009 and according to Council records work started on site in 2008. Therefore from this information, it is clear that work has commenced within the timescales of the three planning permissions .

Following further discussions with the Agent, it was confirmed that planning permission C07A/0863/14 /LL is the consent currently being exercised by the developer, therefore there is no breach of planning control in respect of the development of the flats on the site.

I hope the above responds to your query.”

Members received the response and the Clerk advised that he would make further enquiries regarding the Welsh language, affordable housing and the Unitary Development Plan.
